1 About Web Video Player

1.1 Overview

MagicHTML Web Video Player is a fast and easy way to add video player to your website. The Video Player works as Flash player on Windows, Linux and Mac, and automatically turns into HTML5 video player on iPhone and iPad, thus provides a seamlessly support to all modern devices and web browsers.

The software features a clean and easy to use interface. You can choose a player skin and customize its size to match your website. The video player also supports playlist, full screen mode, progress bar, optional text information and poster images.

You can set up the video player automatically playing or manually playing on startup. You can also set up the autoplay mode when switching between videos.

The software creates the complete HTML code and all required files to insert the video player into your web page.

1.2 Requirements

The program runs on all versions of Windows, including 98, ME, XP, 2000, 2003 Server, Vista and 7, 32bit and 64bit.

You need to install Adobe Flash Player 9 or above in Internet Explorer of your computer. You may visit the page <http://www.adobe.com/products/flashplayer/> with Internet Explorer and install the free Adobe Flash Player.

2.1 Download Full Version

2.2 Download Trial Version



The product is distributed under "try-before-you-buy" principle. This means that you can download the program for free, try it, and make sure the program works for you before you make a purchasing decision. We encourage you to try it out first!

2.3 Installation

Step 1: Unzip the downloaded ZIP file.

Step 2: Launch setup.exe by double-clicking, then follow the on-screen instructions.

Please note, the software itself only runs on Windows system, it does not work on Mac and Linux.




4.1 Main Menu and Toolbar



4.1.1 Project Menu


A project .wvp file is an XML file to save all configurations. You can create a new project, open a saved project file or save the current project with menu item New Project, Open Project and Save Project.

When saving project, you can choose to save all related video and image files to the same folder as the project .wvp file.




4.1.2 Select Web Video Player Style

The program offers Flash video player skins to choose from. You can select a skin from the drop down list or click a skin image.




4.1.3 Customize Flash Player

You can further customize a video player template with the right properties editor.





4.2 Toolbox

4.2.1 Create Video Player

Clicking the button **Create Video Player** will generate all of the required files and help you add the video player to your website.



4.2.7 Insert to Web Page

The software will generate HTML codes which can help you insert the video player to your webpage.

There are two steps to embed the video player to your webpage. Firstly, you need to copy or upload the generated files to the same folder as your web page. Secondly, you need to copy the generated HTML code to the webpage where you want to show the video player.

5.1 General Questions

How will my order be processed? Is it secure?

5.2 Product Questions

I got a runtime access violation error when I launch the software, what should I do?

This may occur if you did not install Adobe Flash Player in Internet Explorer. Please launch Internet Explorer, visit <http://www.adobe.com/products/flashplayer/>, and then install the Adobe Flash player. After installation, restart the software, the problem will be fixed. You may also need to restart your computer.

Does your software run on Windows 7?

Yes. It works on all Windows systems, including Windows 2000, 2003 Server, XP, Vista and 7, both 32 bits and 64 bits.
